



## **Influential conservatives slated to headline Culture Engagement Summit in Memphis Meadows, Blackburn, Starnes and Jeffress are among more than two dozen nationally recognized political and religious leaders confirmed as speakers for the April 30 event**

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — The Citizens for America Foundation, one of the nation’s most effective advocacy and grassroots public policy organizations, will draw national attention to Memphis, Tenn., April 30, when conservatives from across America converge to hear from more than 30 prominent conservative leaders during its Culture Engagement Summit. The summit, set to take place on the campus of Mid-America Baptist Theological Seminary, will focus on equipping and inspiring Christians to engage the culture from a biblical perspective.

Mark Meadows, former White House chief-of-staff to President Donald Trump, has been confirmed as a speaker for the Memphis event along with Fox News contributor and First Baptist Dallas Pastor Robert Jeffress. Sen. Marsha Blackburn (R-TN), best-selling author and journalist Todd Starnes, and Liberty University’s Standing for Freedom Center Executive Director Ryan Helfenbein will also speak during the one-day event.

Chris Hughes, founder and chairman of the Citizens for America Foundation and organizer of the April 30 summit, has a desire to see Christians “impact the culture for Jesus” – a line he employs to conclude each episode of his daily nationally-syndicated radio show, “The Christian Perspective.” He said he looks forward to welcoming to Memphis hundreds of Christians who want to engage in the arenas of public policy and politics.

“Imagine what this nation would look like if Christians turned their faith into action and voted for candidates with a biblical worldview,” Hughes said. “The Church in America has never been more silent about the gospel of Jesus Christ or louder about things that have no eternal consequence. It is time for Christians to take a stand in culture and proclaim the truth of the Word of God.”

Citizens for America has designed its summit in such a way as to equip and inspire Christians from across the conservative landscape in the United States. Among those interested in the Culture Engagement Summit are ministry leaders, pastors, homeschool students, youth groups, political groups, Christian school groups, university students, elected officials, political candidates, and citizens who value the Judeo-Christian values upon which the United States was founded.

The Culture Engagement Summit will help attendees grow in their understanding of what it means to engage cultural issues through a biblical perspective by asking the question, “What does the Bible say” about a wide range of issues Americans find themselves considering and debating today including abortion, gender, cancel culture, Critical Race Theory, marriage, family, economics, politics, the U.S. Constitution, and the veracity of Scripture.

A free lunch is included in the cost of attending the Summit, which will have main stage speakers, breakout sessions, and exhibitors. Various registration levels are available, including \$15 tickets for students and a VIP option for a limited number of attendees who will be given the opportunity to join selected speakers for a light continental breakfast prior to the event.
